I can honestly say Eden Ashley didn't disappoint me. I don't like reading spoilers so I don't write them either, which doesn't mean I can't review a story. First of all, potential readers must keep in mind this is a story told in installments, of which Banewolf is the second installment. That being said, it's obvious one needs to read book 1 for a better understanding of the background of the characters. Moreover, even though the readers get more information in this second part and many questions raised in book 1 are answered, they shouldn't expect to get the whole picture at this point and they should expect more mysteries to unfold. That's actually a given in this kind of story. However, I don't mean to say the book is predictable. On the contrary, it's full of surprises, which contribute to the enjoyment of the story and to the fact you won't want to put the book down. That's why I recommend you start reading the series during Spring break to avoid losing precious sleeping time. LOL
