You're also going to need the players guide to Werewolf, since the Nuwisha book doe NOT contain all of their gifts. NOR does it contain creation rules. It does however, list their Totems, a few gifts, and Nuwisha Only merits and flaws. It also has their creation mythos, and a few secrets. AND AS AN ADDED BONUS, It has Old-man-manyskins in it. Yay, huh?

Nuwisha are were-coyotes. They are Tricksters and warriors for Gaia. This sourcebook includes everything needed to create and play a Nuwisha character. History, culture and myth of the Nuwisha, and much expanded information about Nuwisha magic and Totems is included. There are also ready-to play character templates

The Nuwisha are the eternal pranksters for Gaia. The sacred clowns. This book tells all about them, from the point of view of one of them. So don't expect many answers to be clear as Waterford crystal. Complete and concise.
