

He came out of nowhere in 1974 to become the first Republican mayor of the city Providence, R.I. in more than four decades. He had spent time as an Assistant Attorney General for the State of Rhode

Island prosecuting criminal and organized crime cases. Before long he was hobnobbing with President Gerald Ford at the White House and was viewed by many political pundits as a rising star in the Republican Party. Yes, the sky appeared to be the limit for the savvy young man from Providence. He was bright, articulate, ambitious, energetic, personable and a man of great vision. But he certainly had his work cut out for him. When 33 year old Vincent "Buddy" Cianci was sworn in as mayor in January 1975 the city of Providence was a pretty dreary place.
